**POSSIBILITY OF INCLUDING TRAINING ACTIVITIES AMONG THE INDEPENDENT CHOICES  
FOR THE MASTER DEGREE IN  
CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY FOR INDIVIDUALS, FAMILIES AND ORGANIZATIONS**

The presentation of the study plan includes an indication by the student of 12 credits as an independent choice. To achieve 12 credits you can choose between two 6 credits courses (or modules) or one single 12 credits course (structured as one or two modules).

The online procedure for the completion of the study plan shows a list of courses or modules that can be selected. The list is available as an attachment to this notice and is also valid as a reference for those who must submit the plan on paper form.

If the student wishes to choose a course that is not listed, he/she shall forward the reasoned request to the Teaching Board of the course of study through the Student Office. Only on acceptance by the Teaching Board, the course will be included in the study plan by the Student office.

Certain courses are excluded from the list because of internal regulations and constraints.

If courses that include a module of 3, 5 or 9 training credits are chosen, it must be considered that in order to reach the 12 credits required for the free sessions, a training activity will have to be added which will lead to excess credits, which will be recorded in career as supernumeraries.

The choice of single 6-credit modules of compounds courses is allowed, provided that these are not mandatory in the study plan or already indicated by the student in the guided choices. If a 12-credits course is made up of two modules, students must indicate the 12 credits code only and not the two individual codes of the modules.

In addition, a single module can be chosen only if it is not bound by any prerequisites, according to the directions of the teacher indicated in the program. In this case the entire course must be selected or the single module that is not bound by any prerequisites.
