POSSIBILITY OF INCLUDING TRAINING ACTIVITIES AMONG THE INDEPENDENT CHOICES

FOR THE MASTER DEGREE IN

CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY FOR INDIVIDUALS, FAMILIES AND ORGANIZATIONS

The presentation of the study plan includes an indication for 12 credits that each student can freely choose. To achieve 12 credits you can choose between two 6 credits courses (or modules) or one single 12 credits course (structured as one or two modules).

The online procedure for completing the study plan displays a list of selectable courses or modules, in line with the study program. The list is available as an attachment to this notice and is also valid as a reference for those who must submit the plan on paper form.

If students wish to choose a course that is not listed, they shall forward the request to the Teaching Board of the course of study through the Student Office. The course will be included in the study plan by the Student office, once it gets approved by the Teaching Board. Certain courses are excluded from the list because of internal regulations and constraints.

It's possible to choose single 6-credit modules of compounds courses, provided that these are not mandatory in the study plan or already indicated by the student in the guided choices. If a 12-credits course consists of two modules, students must indicate the 12 credits code only and not the individual codes of the modules.

Additionally, a single module can be chosen as long as it doesn't require any prerequisites, as stated in the program for the course itself. In this case the entire course must be selected or the single module that is not bound by any prerequisites.
